(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Ceoly Grover and Nellie Grover, their heirs and assigns, forever: all my undivided one-half interest in and to

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in One 1 Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds towit:

BEGINNING at an iron stake on the South side of Old Log Ford Road (also known as Pine Log Road) said stake being at the Eastern end of the Enoree River Bridge, said bridge being one mile East of the intersection of Old Log Ford Road and the Enoree Road which also intersects with Highway 25 at a point 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles West of the intersection of said Log Ford Road. Running from said stake in an Easterly direction 600 feet along Old Log Ford Road to an iron stake, said stake being 686 feet West of a light pole No. QJ 19; thence running in a Southerly direction 200 feet to an iron stake; thence running in a westerly direction 550 feet to an iron stake on the bank of the Enoree River; thence running along the bank of the Enoree River in a Northerly direction 200 feet to the point of the beginning.
