Grantee(s), and to the heirs and assigns of said Grantee(s), All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the Northeast side of Don Drive, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S.C., shown as Lot 5 on plat of property of Donald E. Baltz, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, September, 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book Y, at page 46, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds: Beginning at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Don Drive, at joint front corner of Lots 4 and 5, and running thence with the line of Lot 4, N. 32-07 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 57-53 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 6, S. 32-07 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Don Drive; thence with Don Drive, S. 57-53 E. 75 feet to the point of beginning.

AND THE SAID GRANTOR covenants that he has not made, done, committed, executed or suffered any act or acts, thing or things whatsoever, whereby or by means whereof, the above mentioned and described premises, or any part or parcel thereof, now are, or at any time hereafter shall or may be impeached, charged or encumbered in any manner or way whatsoever.
