Nichols and R. O. Nichols, their heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near Travelers Rest, S. C. and being known and designated as Lot No. 2 as shown on a revised map of Lots Numbers 34 through 47 of a subdivision known as Meadowbrook Farms, a plat of which is of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book PF at Page 113, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the southern side of Loraine Drive at the joint front corner of Lots 2 and 3 and running thence S. 03-00 W. 190 feet to a point at the joint rear corner of Lots 2 and 3; thence N. 87-00 W. 133.1 feet to a point on the eastern side of Williams Road at the joint corner of Lots 1 and 2; thence with the eastern side of Williams Road N. 00-55 E. 175.2 feet to a point; thence following the curvature of the southeastern intersection of Williams Road with Loraine Drive (the chord of which is N. 46-58 E. 20.8 feet) to a point; thence with the southern side of Loraine Drive S. 37-00 E. 125 feet to the point of beginning.
