Johnnie Plumley, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that lot of land in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in Highland Township, on S C Highway 101, being described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin at the corner of property of Wilson and Mary Roe, as shown in plat book T at page 303, and Nancy W. Finley, at a point in the center of S C Hwy. 101, approximately 1,138 feet northwest of the intersection of S. C. Hwy. 44 and S. C Hwy. 414, and running thence along the Roe property, N 20 E, approximately 225 feet; thence N 61-25 W, 214.5 feet; thence along Fred E Howard, S 20 W, 215 feet, more or less, to a point in the center of said road; thence approximately S 60 E, 214.5 feet to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, John Heiskell Roe, Jr., died intestate on September 14, 1920, as will appear in Apt. 163, File 9, owning the property described herein, and whereas he left his widow, Nancy Mae Roe, and three children, Carroll Heiskell Roe, John Earle Roe, and Wilson Roe. Subsequently in 1941 in deed book 240 at page 77, Mrs. A. A. Finley (formerly Nancy Mae Roe) deeded said property to B. F. Dill and in subsequent conveyances in deed book 281, page 320, book 437, page 481, and book 437, page 487, the property was purchased by Johnnie Plumley in 1951.

Carroll H. Roe died testate October 4, 1959, as will appear in Apt. 719, File 1, wherein he willed all of his property unto his wife, the grantor herein.
