To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

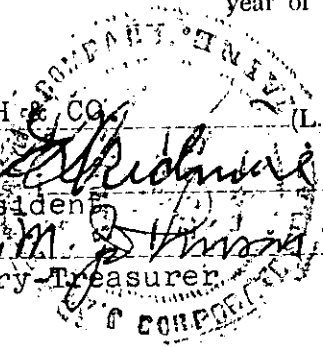

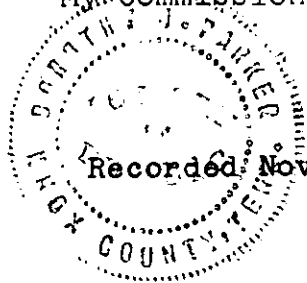
