CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS,

J. D. HUNT, JR., 911 Woodland Dr., Columbia, S. C.

and

MARION HUNT GRAYDON, Route 2, Laurel, West Columbia, S. C.

did on the 2nd day of February, 1959, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is HUNT DEVELOPMENT COMPANY, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is U. S. Highway 21, near Interstate 26, south of CAYCE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is borrow money, construct buildings, enter into leases for the same, and other matters incidental to the ownership and control of its properties.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Three Thousand (\$3,000.00) Dollars payable in cash upon incorporation.

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Thousand (1,000) of the par value of Three (\$3.00) Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 31st day of December, 1958, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: J. D. Hunt, Jr. and Marion Hunt Graydon

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, J. D. Hunt, Jr.; as Vice-President, Marion Hunt Graydon; as Secretary, Marion Hunt Graydon; as Treasurer, J. D. Hunt, Jr.

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The State

a newspaper published in the County of Richland

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
