in the State aforesaid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Claude Mack Garrett and Mrs. Claude Mack Garrett, their heirs, and assigns, forever:

"ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, described as Lot One Hundred Sixty Five (165) in Section Five (5) of Graceland Cemetery, said lot being 10 by 20 feet, containing 200 square feet, consisting of six (6) graves; this being the same land conveyed to R. W. Davidson and T. N. Davidson by Graceland Cemetery by deed dated June 12, 1942, recorded June 11, 1943, in Volume 254, on page 164, in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County, South Carolina."

This deed is made subject to existing regulations of Graceland Cemetery.

Myrtle King Davidson is the sole heir at law of R. W. Davidson.

And I (We) do hereby bind Myself (Ourselves) and My (Our) Heirs, Executors and Administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Claude Mack Garrett and Mrs. Claude Mack Garrett, their Heirs and Assigns, against Me (Us) and My (Our) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same or any part thereof.
