SANITARY SEWER LINE

For consideration satisfactory and acceptable to it, Greenville County does hereby sell, transfer, and convey unto the Town of Simpsonville all of that Sanitary Sewer Line, including pipelines, piers, manholes, rights-of-way, and any other adjuncts used in said sewer line; which line was constructed at the expense of the grantor and which line is located between the Greenville County Rehabilitation Camp and the present sewage system of the Town of Simpsonville and having such courses and distances as shown by plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated August 9, 1961, revised December, 1961, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Volume VV, at Pages 168, 170, 171, and 172.

The grantor hereby warrants and agrees that it will save the Town of Simpsonville harmless from any and all claims of any kind or nature whatsoever in connection with the construction of such lines, and also any terms, conditions and liabilities assumed by the grantor in and to the rights-of-way and easements herein conveyed, together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the grantee and the grantee's heirs or successors and assigns, forever. And, the grantor does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular said premises unto the grantee and the grantee's heirs or successors and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

As a part of the consideration for this conveyance, the Town of Simpsonville agrees to furnish sewage service to the Rehabilitation Camp owned by Greenville County, subject only to the compliance of Greenville County ^{with} the sewage regulations of the Town of Simpsonville.
