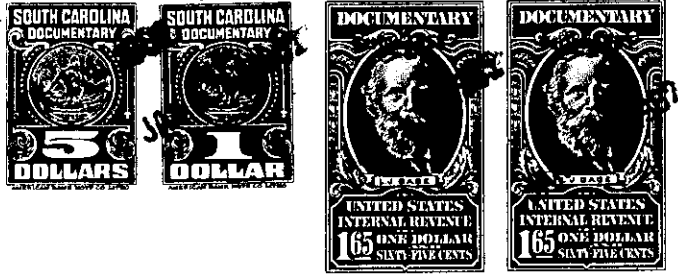

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. C. Burnett, his heirs and assigns forever:

All those pieces, parcels or lots of land lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lots Nos. 1033 and 1035 as appear on a plat of the Jervey Section of Lake Lanier Development, said plat made June 6, 1925, and recorded in Plat Book G, page 35, RMC Office for Greenville County. Lot No. 1033 was conveyed to F. J. Bostick by deed recorded in Deed Book 208, page 196, and Deed Book 219, page 281. Lot No. 1035 was conveyed to F. J.
