CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

Jean A. Galloway and M. A. Merline

of

Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 16th day of January, 1963, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration

signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **FAIRFIELD FIRESTONE - SOUTH CAROLINA, INCORPORATED**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is 409 East North Street, Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

To buy, sell, trade, manufacture, deal in, and deal with goods, wares, merchandise, and personal property of every kind and nature, and to carry on such business as wholesalers, retailers, importers and exporters; to acquire all such merchandise, supplies, materials and other articles as shall be necessary or incidental to such business.

To engage in and to own, operate, and run, conduct and manage the business of repairing and reconditioning automobiles, automotive and mechanical products, and other personal property of any and every sort, character, nature and description. To test and experiment with, including by road tests and racing, automobiles, automotive and mechanical products, including equipment and accessories of all types.

In general, to carry on any other business in connection with the foregoing, and to have and exercise all the powers conferred by the laws of South Carolina upon corporations formed under the laws of the State of South Carolina and to do any or all of the things hereinbefore set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do.
