That the general nature of the business which it proposes to do is to construct, manufacture, distribute, purchase, or otherwise acquire, repair, rent, exchange, take upon storage, sell at wholesale or retail, and in every other manner deal in and with asphalt mixers, spreaders, driers, and any and all types machinery and equipment used or usable in connection with or incidental to grading, paving, contracting, or commercial or industrial work; to purchase, own, hold, mortgage, lease, sell, convey, and in every other manner deal in and with all material, equipment, and real or personal property necessary, convenient, or useful in the prosecution of said business; to enter into and perform contracts for all types industrial and commercial work, including grading and paving; to purchase, acquire, apply for, register, take and make assignments of, secure, or own letters patent, patent rights, trademarks, or inventions, subject to royalties or other claims or charges or otherwise, exclusive or non-exclusive, or any part or interest or right or claim of in or to such letters patent, patent rights, trademarks, or inventions, in any place or part of the world; to sell, let, grant, and in every manner dispose of letters patent, patent rights, trademarks, or inventions, or any part or interest or right or claim of in or to the same, belonging in whole or in part to the company; and, to engage in or perform any enterprise or act that it is lawful for corporations to engage in or perform under the laws of South Carolina.
