his Heirs and Assigns, against US and our Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

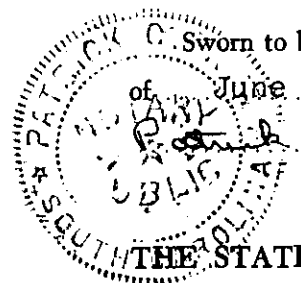

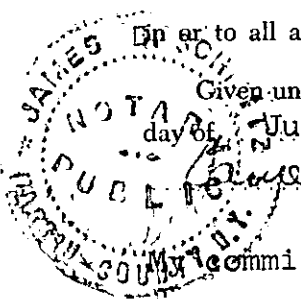
