**CHARTER**  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

Jack L. Bloom, 210 Croft Street, Greenville, South Carolina

and

Catherine Pearson, 418 Randall Terrace, Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 27th day of March, 19 63, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **DAG, INC.**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **Cedar Lane Road, Greenville, South Carolina**

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to own, operate, manage, lease, sell, dispose of, and deal in and with restaurants of all kinds, including but not limited to drive-in and carry-out restaurants, and in and with facilities, real estate, personal property, equipment, appliances, supplies, stores, shops, offices, and department of all kinds; to buy, sell, make, prepare, distribute, and deal in and with food, food products, and beverages, and the ingredients thereof, and generally to do any and all things which may be necessary or convenient to carry out its purposes.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **Twenty Thousand (\$20,000.00)**-----Dollars payable in money, property, or labor

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **Two Hundred (200)** of the par value of **One Hundred (\$100.00)**-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **26th** day of **March**, 19 **63**, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: **Jack L. Bloom, Catherine Pearson**

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **Jack L. Bloom** ;  
as Vice-President, **Catherine Pearson** ; as Secretary, **Catherine Pearson** ;  
as Treasurer, **Jack L. Bloom**

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **The Greenville Piedmont** a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
