in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto said Charles Langston and Carolyn Langston, their heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being a part of an 85.35 acre tract conveyed to E. H. Langston by E. W. Lynch in a deed recorded in the office of Clerk of Court for Greenville County in Deed Book 503, Page 519 and being more definitely described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west side of Highway No. 50, 830 feet north along said highway from the intersection of said highway and the south boundary of the above mentioned 85.35 acre tract; thence west and perpendicular to the highway for a distance of 450 feet; thence north and parallel to the highway for a distance of 130 feet; thence east 450 feet to the highway; thence south along the highway 130 feet to the point of beginning.
