Blackwell and Margaret C. Blackwell and their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain parcel or lot of land situated on the east side of State Highway No. 14 and the south side of Lawton Avenue, between the City of Greer and Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, Chick Springs Township; Greenville County, South Carolina, and being Lot No. 7 of the J.A. Wood Estate according to survey and plat by John A. Simmons, Registered Surveyor, dated February 6, 1963, recorded in Plat Book DDD, page 21, R.M.C.
