CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

Fletcher C. Mann and David A. Quattlebaum, III,

of

P. O. Box 2248, Greenville, South Carolina

did on the 7th day of May, 1963, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is SWITZER INDUSTRIALS, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is Greenville, South Carolina

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to manufacture, store, distribute, sell, supply, install and repair industrial and textile supplies, equipment, tools, machinery and compounds of all types; to buy, sell, import, export, store, warehouse, distribute, process, manufacture, fabricate, market and trade in and deal in and with, at wholesale and retail and in every other manner, industrial and textile equipment, supplies, goods, materials and compounds of every kind and character; to engage in the buying, selling, owning, leasing and management of real estate.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars payable in cash

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is One Hundred (100) of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 30th day of April, 1963, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: Fletcher C. Mann, David A. Quattlebaum, III

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Fletcher C. Mann; as Vice-President, David A. Quattlebaum, III; as Secretary, David A. Quattlebaum, III; as Treasurer, David A. Quattlebaum, III

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in Greenville Piedmont

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
