That I, T. A. Cothran, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars and other valuable consideration, the same being the division of property, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. G. Cothran, his heirs and assigns forever:

All my undivided one-half interest in and to all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being on the northeasterly side of Beech Springs Road, near the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as property of T. A. Cothran on a plat entitled "Property of J. G. Cothran and T. A. Cothran", as recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book DDD, page 91, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northeasterly side of Beech Springs Road, said pin being located in the middle of the right-of-way of said Road and being the joint corner of property formerly owned by T. A. Cothran, J. G. Cothran and T. A. Cothran, Jr., and running thence along the right-of-way of said Road N 29-15 W 145 feet to an iron pin; thence N 60-45 E 175 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence S 29-15 E 145 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly belonging to T. A. Cothran, Jr.; thence S 60-45-W 175 feet, more or less, to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
