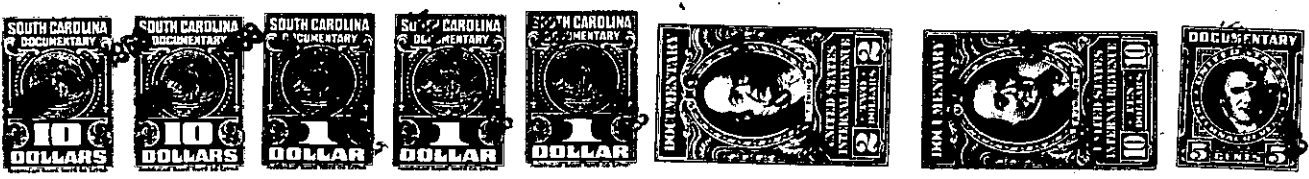

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto **JAMES ARTHUR HAMPTON WYATT:**

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Western side of Collinwood Lane near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 26 as shown on a plat of Collinwood Park, prepared by J.C. Hill, Engineer, dated October, 1962, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book CCC at page 27, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Collinwood Lane at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 25 N. 77-0 W. 150 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 24; thence with the line of Lot No. 24 S. 13-0 W. 80 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 24, 26 and 28; thence with the lines of Lots Nos. 28 and 27 S. 77-0 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Collinwood Lane; thence with the Western side of Collinwood Lane N. 13-0 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.
