in consideration of **Six Hundred Seventy-Two and 75/100 (\$672.75)** Dollars,

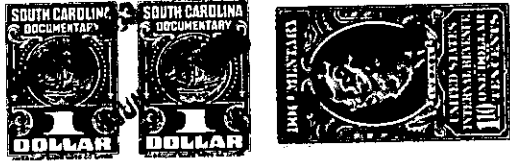
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto
