All that piece, parcel and strip of land situate, lying and being on the eastern side of the Staunton Bridge Road, Gantt Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having, according to a plat "Proposed widening ten-foot road, Greenville County, South Carolina", prepared by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, June, 1963, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin situate in the center of an unnamed existing ten foot road on the eastern side of Staunton Bridge Road and running thence with the center line of said unnamed road S. 71-15 E. 220.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 18-45 E. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the proposed street in a southerly direction, said curve having a 25 foot radius (the chord of which is S. 60-45 W. 30.1 feet to an iron pin); thence N. 71-15 W. 196.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 18-42 W. 31 feet to the point of beginning.
