Edward H. Hembree, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 28 on Schwiers Garden as shown on a Plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book YY, at Page 127, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Cleveland Street at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 28 and running thence with the Western side of said Cleveland Street N. 27-27 W. 156.7 feet to the curvature of the intersection of Cleveland Street and Landsdown Avenue; thence with the curvature of said intersection the chord of which is N. 73-44 W. 34.6 feet; thence with the Southern side of Landsdown Avenue S. 60-00 W. 140.0 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 27-27 E. 174.35 feet to an iron pin in the joint line of Lots 21 and 28; thence with the joint line of said lots N. 62-35 E. 165.0 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Cleveland Street, the point of beginning; subject to the five foot drainage easement along the side and rear lot line as shown on the recorded plat and subject to the Restrictive and Protective Covenants applicable to Schwiers Garden recorded in the said R.
