That we, HENRY K. TOWNES and MARJORIE C. TOWNES in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 ----- in the State aforesaid, DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said ELLEN T. TAYLOR, her heirs and assigns forever, all our right, title and interest in and to the following described land:

ALL that tract of land in Greenville County, South Carolina on Bent Bridge Road and near the Easley Bridge Road (U.S. 123 alternate) containing 0.70 acres, more or less, and shown on a plat of the property of Mrs. R. K. Taylor, Jr. made by Webb Survey and Mapping Company, April 25, 1963, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book DDD at page 131, having, according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the intersection of Bent Bridge Road and a county road and running thence with the eastern side of Bent Bridge Road N. 22 - 42 W., 257 feet to an iron pin (which pin is 133 feet, more or less, from the center of the Easley Bridge Road); thence N. 69 - 30 E., 245 feet to an iron pin on the western side of the county road; thence with the western side of said county road, S. 20 - 57 W., 231.4 feet to an iron pin; thence still with the western side of said road, S. 23 - 57 W., 117 feet to the beginning corner.

The purpose of this deed is to convey any interest which may have been held by the grantors under the deed to them and others made by Ellen H. Townes and recorded in Vol. 613 at page 235 of the Greenville County RMC Office.

TOGETHER with all and Singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and her Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s') Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s') Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
