HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto
the said Lee Evett, all the right, title and interest of the minor petitions Arthur B. Hart, Jr., in and to the following described real estate:
"ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Eastern side of Marion Road, near the City of Greenville, being a portion of Lots 113 and 114, as shown on a plat of Parker Heights, recorded in Plat Book "P" at Page 43 and described, according to a survey made by J. C. Hill on October 17, 1959, as follows:
BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Marion Road, 100 feet South from View Point Drive, and running thence with the Eastern side of said Road, S. 30-45 W. 105.5 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 110; thence with the line of said lot, S. 59-15 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 30-45 E. 87.1 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 48-51 W. 101.6 feet to the Beginning Corner.
