

This is the identical property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Stuart L. Barber dated January 21, 1963, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 715 at page 68.

This deed is an absolute conveyance of title in effect as well as in form and is not intended as a mortgage, trust conveyance or security of any kind. The consideration therefor is the full release of all debts, obligations, costs and charges heretofore subsisting on account of and by terms of that certain mortgage from Glendon P. Jones and Marjorie Adelle L. Jones to General Mortgage Co. and assigned to The Life Insurance Company of Virginia, dated November 10, 1959 and recorded in the R.M.C.
