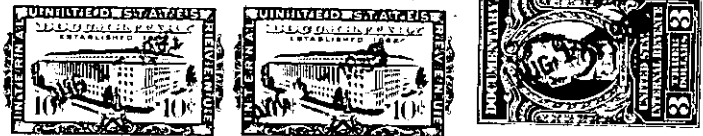
in consideration of the sum of Eleven Thousand Nine Hundred and No/100ths (\$11,900.00) --

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto VICTOR O. SOWERS, JR., W. CLAUDE READER AND M.R. FULLER, AS TRUSTEES OF FELLOWSHIP BAPTIST CHURCH:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Collinwood Lane and Greenway Court near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 17 as shown on a plat of Collinwood Park, prepared by J.C. Hill, Engineer, dated October, 1962, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book CCC at page 27, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southwestern corner of the intersection of Collinwood Lane and Greenway Court, and running thence with the Southern side of Greenway Court N. 77-0 W. 150 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 16 and 17; thence with the line of Lot No. 16 S. 13-0 W. 80 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18; thence with the line of Lot No. 18 S. 77-0 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Collinwood Lane; thence with the Western side of Collinwood Lane N. 13-0 E. 80 feet to the point of beginning.

This is a portion of the property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed of Carl Hammond, dated October 26, 1962, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 709 at page 494.
