to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William W. Taylor, Jr.

All that lot of land situate on the west side of Carolina Avenue, near the city of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 38 on plat of Section A, of Gower Estates made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers January 1960, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book QQ at pages 146 and 147 and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the west side of Carolina Avenue at joint front corner of Lots No. 37 & 38, and runs thence with the line of Lot No. 37, S. 86-54 W. 231.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-20 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 39 S. 78-58 E. 186.6 feet to an iron pin on the west side of Carolina Avenue; thence along Carolina Avenue S. 22-21 W. 63 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Carolina Avenue (the chord being S. 16-44 W. 22.3 feet) to the beginning corner.

This is the same lot conveyed to grantor by Conyers & Gower, Inc. by deed recorded March 26, 1962 in deed volume 695 page 125 of the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., and is conveyed subject to restrictions applicable to said subdivision recorded in vol. 663 page 118.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

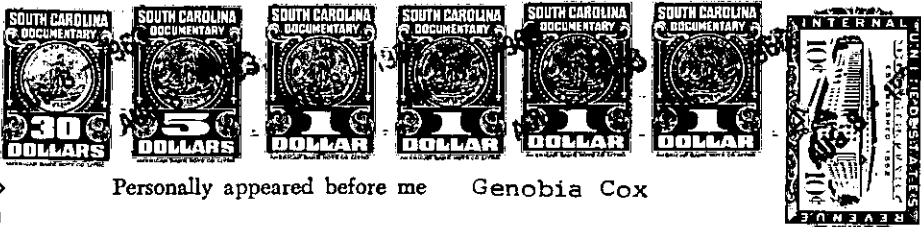
