All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a pin, corner of the Florence T. Harris lot, on the north side of Asbury Street, formerly John Street, 85 feet from the north-east corner of Asbury, formerly John Street, and Lloyd Streets, and running thence with the north side of Asbury Street, formerly John Street, S. 50 E. 149 feet, 9 inches to the corner of the N. J. Galloway lot; thence N. 40 E. 134 feet to the rear corner of the Galloway lot; thence N. 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 147 feet, 6 inches to a pin, corner of Florence T.
