Know All Men by These Presents, That I (We) the said, Walter G. Sweet

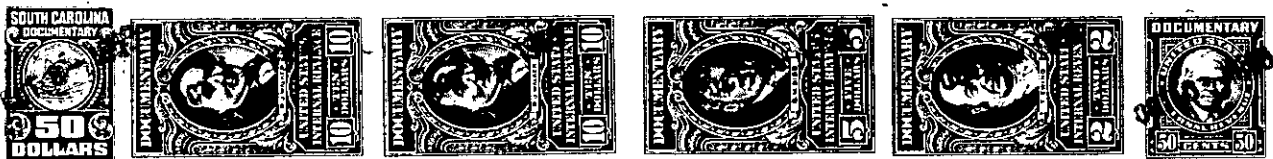
