# CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

John E. Mickler, Greenville, South Carolina

and

Melvin K. Younts, Fountain Inn, South Carolina

did on the 29th day of October, 1963, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **PLASTIC PRODUCTS, INC.**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **18 Santuck Street, Greenville, S. C.**

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is the production of chemicals and various types of raw materials for combinations of various finished products and the fabrication of various types of finished products into particular uses; to buy, sell, trade and lease real and personal property on a wholesale and retail basis, and to perform engineering, designing and consultation services with plastic products, chemicals, metal, wood, and organic products, with the further right to act as agent and representative for numerous principals, and to deal generally in any type business enterprise not prohibited by the Laws of the State of South Carolina, and the United States of America.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00)**-----Dollars payable **in cash**

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **Five Thousand (5,000)** of the par value of **Ten (\$10.00)**-----Dollars

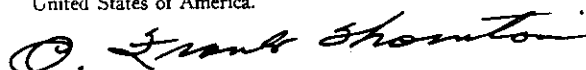
SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **15th** day of **October**, 1963, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: **John E. Mickler, Melvin K. Younts**

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **Melvin K. Younts** ; as Vice-President, ; as Secretary, **John E. Mickler** ; as Treasurer, **John E. Mickler** ;

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by *bona fide* subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in **Greenville Piedmont** a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
