to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. Sumner Tanner, Charlotte G. Tanner, Ernest Blakely, Jr., Sally H. Blakely, W. Harry King, Dorothy C. King, E. Hays Reynolds, Suzannè J. Reynolds, C. Lawson Scott and Martha S. Scott, their heirs and assigns forever,

all that tract or lot of land lying, situate and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the western side of Pleasantburg Drive (South Carolina Highway 291), and being known and designated as Lot No. 2 on plat of survey by R. K. Campbell of property of Mrs. B. Kate Moore dated October 12, 1960, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the western edge of the right-of-way of a frontage road connecting with Pleasantburg Drive, said point being 160 feet north of the intersection of said right-of-way with Ravencrest Drive, and running thence N. 71-30 W. 367 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-12 W. 135 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot #3, S. 76-30 E. 387.3 feet to an iron pin on frontage road; thence with the curve of said road, S. 3-19 E. 80 feet to a point; thence S. 8-25 W. 80 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
