WHEREAS, the School District of Greenville County (herein called "School District") is the successor to Parker School District and Deering-Milliken, Inc. is the successor to Judson Mills, a corporation, and as such has title to all the properties constituting what is known as Judson Mills, including certain surrounding or neighboring property; and

WHEREAS, by general warranty deed dated November 29, 1962, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 725 at page 309, the School District, for valuable consideration, conveyed to Deering-Milliken, Inc. the aforementioned lot (less a portion thereof conveyed to Greenville County for road purposes); and
