County, State of South Carolina, about one mile northeast of Washinton Baptist Church, lying on the north side of Beaver Dam Creek and on the west side of the road that leads from Washington Baptist Church to the Jordan Road, and being a part of the Home Place of the late H. J. Ponder, which was left to the grantee# herein and the grantors, jointly, by the will of the said H. J. Ponder, now deceased, being bounded on the north by lands of Herman Ponder, on the east by the said road, on the south by the said Beaver Dam Creek and other lands of the Grantors and grantee herein, and on the west by Rands formerly of J.
