GREENVILLE COUNTY }

THIS INDENTURE, made and entered into this 5th day of February, 1964,
by and between **CHARLES H. HENDERSON**

hereinafter called "Grantor" (whether one or more), and DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey corporation, hereinafter called "Grantee";

WITNESSETH:

That Grantor, in consideration of \$175.00.....paid by Grantee, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does grant and convey unto Grantee, its successors and assigns, the right to erect, construct, reconstruct, replace, maintain and use towers, poles, wires, lines, cables, and all necessary and proper foundations, footings, crossarms and other appliances and fixtures for the purpose of transmitting electric power and for Grantee's communication purposes, together with a right of way, on, along and in all of the hereinafter described tract(s) of land lying and being in.....Greenville.....County, South Carolina, and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the southwesterly corner of the property of the Grantor and runs thence with an easterly line of the R. M. Lusk property N 10-49 E 19.7 ft.; thence S 36-16 E 18.8 ft.; thence with a northerly line of the R. M. Lusk property S 74-22 W 15.4 ft. to the BEGINNING, containing .003 acre.
