All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Gantt Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the Southwestern side of White Horse Road at the intersection of Terry Court and being known and designated as all of lot number THIRTEEN (13) of the property of L. M. Mahon known as Roseman Heights as shown by plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, dated September, 1952, and recorded in plat book "T", page 473, Greenville County R. M. C. Office and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and Heirs and Assigns forever.

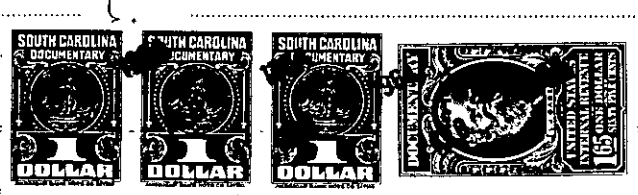
