CHARTER BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

John W. Orvin and Edna B. Orvin

of

P. O. Box 482, Charleston, South Carolina

did on the 15th day of January, 1962, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is **PIEDMONT NURSING HOME, INC.**

THIRD: That the principal place of business is **Greenville County, South Carolina**

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to own, operate and manage a nursing home for aged and invalid persons and to do any and all things necessary to the maintenance, ownership and operating of said business and to deal generally in any business enterprises directly or indirectly advantageous to the principal business and in accordance with the laws of the State of South Carolina and of the United States of America, and to have and exercise any and all rights and powers usually conferred upon institutions of this character.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is **One Hundred Fifty Thousand (\$150,000.00)** Dollars payable **50% subscribed to and 20% paid in**

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is **One Hundred Fifty Thousand (150,000)** of the par value of **One (\$1.00)**-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the **27th** day of **December**, 19**61**, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the following were elected directors: **John W. Orvin and Edna B. Orvin**

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, **John W. Orvin** ;
as Vice-President, ; as Secretary, **Edna B. Orvin** ;
as Treasurer,

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amendments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed by *bona fide* subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given **The Greenville Piedmont**

a newspaper published in the County of **Greenville**

NOW, THEREFORE, **I. O. FRANK THORNTON**, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
