to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Thomas C. Brissey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these  
presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THOMAS C. BRISSEY, his heirs  
and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Robin  
Hood Road, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South  
Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 148 on Plat of Sherwood Forest made  
by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1951, revised through June,  
1953, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in  
Plat Book GG, at pages 70 and 71, and having according to said Plat,  
the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the West side of Robin Hood Road, at joint  
front corner of Lots Nos. 147 and 148, and running thence with the line  
of Lot No. 147, N. 81-55 W. 179 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 12-50 E.  
75.26 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 149, S.  
81-55 E. 172.8 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Robin Hood Road;  
thence along the West side of Robin Hood Road, S. 8-05 W. 75 feet to  
the beginning corner.
