All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the south side of East Earle Street, and having, according to a plat recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book C, at page 171, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
