This Indenture, made this 3rd day October in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-three between Fred Chandler, Calvin Chandler and Roy Chandler,

as Executor S of the last Will and Testament of W.C. Chandler, late of Greer in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, deceased, of the first part, and Roy W. Chandler

of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That the said parties of the first part, by virtue of the authority to them given in and by the said last Will and Testament, and in consideration of the sum of Seventy-Nine Hundred (\$7900.00) - - - - Dollars to them Paid by the said parties of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL AND RELEASE unto the said parties of the second part his Heirs and Assigns forever, ALL THE ESTATE, right, title, interest, property possession, claim and demand whatsoever, both in law and equity, which the said Testator had at the time of his decease; and which the said parties of the first part have by virtue of said last Will and Testament of W.C. Chandler deceased, of, in and to:

All that parcel or tract of land in Oneal Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, located about three miles north of the City of on the north side of highway leading from State Highway No. 14 to State Highway No. 101, being all of Tract No. 1 on a plat of property made for the W.C. Chandler Estate by John A. Simmons, Registered Surveyor, dated August 26, 1963, recorded in Plat Book YY, page 149, R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stake in center of road leading from said highway at the Chandler place, joint front corner of Tracts Nos. 1 and 2 (iron pin at 15 feet from true corner), and runs thence along the center of Gully as the line as follows: N. 19-20 W. 277.5 feet to stake, N. 8-20 W. 78 feet to stake, N. 25-5 W. 158 feet to stake, and N. 3-40 E. 104 feet to center of spring; thence N. 45-30 E. 33 feet to an iron pin on bank of branch; thence N. 35-57 W. 401 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 31-27 E. 180 feet to old iron pin; thence S. 89-52 E. 566.1 feet to an iron pin near dirt road; thence S. 3-06 W. 463.1 feet to old iron pin; thence S. 73 E. 312.5 feet to a stake in community road (iron pin on west bank at 12.5 feet from true corner); thence along and with said road, S. 3-50 E. 400 feet to a stake in main highway; thence along and with said highway, S. 72-40 W. 530 feet to a stake at intersection of two highways; thence continuing with road, N. 85-45 W. 73 feet to the beginning corner, containing 14.63 acres, more or less.

The late W.C. Chandler by his last will and testament gave his wife, Lessie G. Chandler, a life estate in all of his real estate, and directed that upon her death all of his real estate should be equally

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
