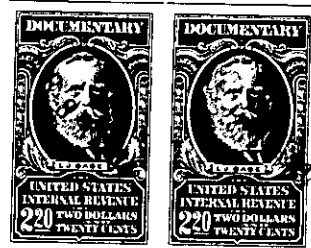

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT
THE MOST REVEREND FRANCIS F. REH, as The Bishop of Charleston, a Corporation sole under
the laws of the State of South Carolina,

in the State aforesaid _____ in consideration of the sum of
Four Thousand Thirteen and 90/100 (\$4,013.90) ----- DOLLARS,

to me _____ in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by MAGLA MICHAEL

in the State aforesaid _____ the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto the said MAGLA MICHAEL, her heirs and assigns forever

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land being situate on the North side of Pinckney Street
in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and being
more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Pinckney Street, 94.5 feet from Fludd
Street and running thence N 57-14 E 198.7 feet to an iron pin; thence N 33-18 W 105
feet to a stake; thence S 56-41 W 25 feet to a stake; thence N 34-00 W 55 feet to
an iron pin; thence S 56-41 W 175 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Pinckney
Street; thence along the North side of Pinckney Street S 34-00 E 157.8 feet to the
beginning corner, according to plat made by J. Mac Richardson, Registered Land Surveyor,
March 2, 1950.

Being the same property conveyed to the grantor herein by deed recorded in the RMC

1953, and executed by The Central Baptist Church.

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
