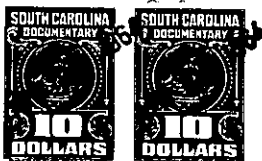

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Vera M. Taylor,

in consideration of Ten Thousand and No/100 (\$10,000.00)----- Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto Jimmy R. Willis and Carlotta J. Willis, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on the eastern side of Bent Twig Drive and being known and designated as Lot No. 20 of Biltmore as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "Y", at Page 147 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Bent Twig Drive at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 19 and 20 and running thence along said Drive N. 14-46 E. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 20 and 21 S. 75-14 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 14-46 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 19 and 20 N. 75-14 W. 150 feet to the point of beginning.
