Nolin in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of - - FIVE THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 ***** DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said JAMES L. BURGIN, his heirs and assigns forever,

ALL that piece, parcel or tract of land with all improvements thereon about 3 1/2 miles West of Simpsonville in Austin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 18 acres, more or less. This being the remaining portion of the 38-acre tract conveyed to Fred L. and Jo Inez T. Von Borstel by deed recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 648, at page 427 and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:
