All that lot of land situate on the southeast side of Pittman Circle, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 12 on plat of property of J. A. and Maggie B. Pittman made by R. K. Campbell, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book RR, page 143, and having according to a more recent survey made by C. C. Jones, Engineer, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the southeast side of Pittman Circle at joint front corner of Lots 12 and 13, and runs thence with the line of Lot 13, S. 33-50 E. 139.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 56-10 W. 84.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81-45 W. 167.8 feet to an iron pin on the southeast side of Pittman Circle; thence along Pittman Circle N. 43-22 E. 111.4 feet to an iron pin; thence still along Pittman Circle N. 54-57 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.

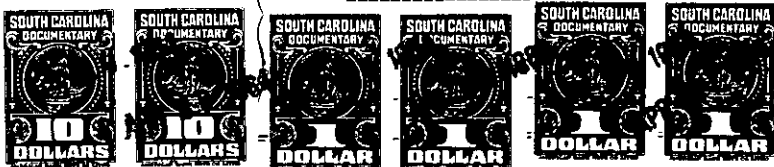
