in consideration of Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred and 00/100 ----- (\$14,500.00) ----- Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
unto Gary R. King and Ann B. King, their heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 32 of a subdivision known as Section 2, Fenwick Heights, according to a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineering Service, March, 1959 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ, at Page 45, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeasterly side of Fairlawn Circle, joint front corner of Lots 32 and 33, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 30-04 E. 179.3 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 31; thence with the line of Lot No. 31, S. 55-37 W. 102.7 feet to an iron pin on the easterly side of said Fairlawn Circle; thence with the easterly side of said Fairlawn Circle, N. 36-33 W. 129.8 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curvature of said Fairlawn Circle, the chord of which is N. 10-00 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 56-30 E. 72 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to me by Grady B. Nicholson, Jr. by deed dated May 2, 1963 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 722, at Page 464.
