ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, together with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the North side of Carroll Lane in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 5 on plat of property of Helen B. McDaniel, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, April, 1948, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book U, Page 45, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of Carroll Iane, at joint front corner of Lots 6 and 5, running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 1-09 E., 262.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 88-47 E., 80.9 feet to an iron pin; thence along joint line of Lots 4 and 5, S. 1-09 W., 223.5 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Carroll Iane; thence along the North side of Carroll Iane, S. 65-40 W., 90 feet to the point of beginning.

ALSO, all my right, title and interest in and to that easement and right of way for a sewer line running from the rear of the above described property in a Northerly direction to Watts Avenue, as more particularly described in a deed from Anne Smith and Jeannie S. Bishop, dated December 15, 1948, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book 368, Page 124.
