the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

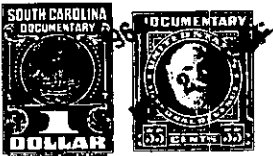
Leland Worthy, his heirs and assigns forever:

Massingale, made by J. Hoke Smith in May 1947 and described according to a plat made by J. C. Hill on August 25, 1945 as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Hellene Street at the corner of property now or formerly belonging to Hammond and running thence S. 79-45 W. 116 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 28-50 W. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 60-40 E. 25.2 feet to an iron pin in Hellene Street; thence with Hellene Street S. 65 E. 145 feet to the beginning corner.

Being the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed dated January 13, 1962 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 703, Page 241.
