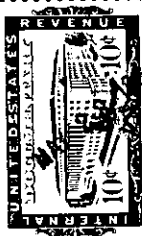

in consideration of EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED FIFTY AND NO/100 Dollars,

the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto

JOHN WILLIAM MADISON, SR., his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying on the eastern side of the intersection of Thomas Drive with Hemlock Street, near Travelers Rest, Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot 28 on a plat of the property of John and Lynell Peterson, recorded in Plat Book PP, Page 85, being more particularly shown on a plat of property of Robert F. Pitman, Jr., prepared by Jones and Sutherland dated February 2, 1960, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeastern side of Thomas Drive directly behind a utility pole and running thence with the southeastern side of said drive S. 48-15 W. 75 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Thomas Drive with Hemlock Street, the chord of which is S. 2-0 W. 34.6 feet to an iron pin on the northeastern side of Hemlock Street; thence with the northeastern side of said street S. 44-15 E. 115 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 48-15 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 44-15 W 140 feet to the beginning corner
