WHEREAS, our father, E. W. Davis, by deed dated September 9, 1943, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 257 at page 367, conveyed to us the remainder estate in that certain lot of land first described below; and,

WHEREAS, our mother, Nobie May Davis, by deed dated September 9, 1943, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Book 257 at page 368, conveyed to us, the remainder estate in that certain lot of land last described below; and,

WHEREAS, when said deeds were executed, we were the only children of our said parents, but since the execution of said deeds two other children have been born unto our said parents, and we desire that all of our parents' children shall share equally in the remainder interests in the said lots.

Now, Therefore, in consideration of the circumstances aforesaid, and for One (\$1.00) Dollar to us in hand paid by the said two children, namely: Deborah Rebecca Davis and John Stevens Davis, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, we have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said:

Deborah Rebecca Davis, and,  
John Stevens Davis, their heirs  
and assigns forever,

a one-sixth undivided interest each, that is:

a one-sixth undivided interest to Deborah Rebecca Davis,  
her heirs and assigns,  
and a one-sixth undivided interest to John Stevens Davis,  
his heirs and assigns,

of our remainder interest in and to:
