the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release

unto Dr. W. F. Gibson, his heirs and assigns forever:

ALL that lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot Number 5 on a Plat of Property of Fred D. and Mamie W. Garrett, Harrison Rearden, Dr. W. F. Gibson, and Myrtle Pickens, as shown on a plat thereof made by C. O. Riddle, Surveyor, dated, March, 1964, noted in Plat Book GGG at page 105, Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
