KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Boyce B. Norton,

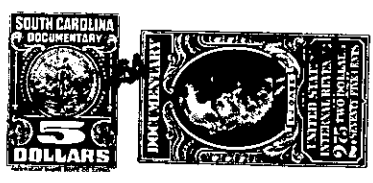
in consideration of Twenty-Five Hundred and No/100-----(\$ 2500.00)----- Dollars,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto W. E. Humphries, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying and being on the south side of Super Highway U. S. No. 29 and on the southwest corner of the intersection of said Super Highway U. S. No. 29 and old U. S. No. 29, containing 2-1/2 acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake at the southwestern corner of the intersection of the right-of-way of Old U. S. No. 29 and the right-of-way of Super Highway U. S. No. 29, and running thence along the right-of-way along the south side of Super Highway U. S. No. 29 in a westerly direction 290 feet, more or less, to a stake on the right-of-way of the Chick Springs-Fairview Road (also known as Rutherford Road); thence along the right-of-way on the eastern side of the Chick Springs-Fairview Road (also known as Rutherford Road), in a southern direction to the intersection of the said Chick Springs-Fairview Road and Old U. S. Highway No. 29; thence along the right-of-way of Old U. S. Highway No. 29, in an northeasterly direction 1,060 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

Said property is bounded on the north by Super Highway U. S. No. 29, on the east by Old U. S. No. 29, on the south by the intersection of Old U. S. No. 29 and the Chick Springs-Fairview Road, and on the west by the Chick Springs-Fairview Road. Said lot is triangular in shape and is shown on the Greenville County Block Book as Lot 51, Block 1, Sheet T-9.5.
