That We, Joseph J. Nannarello and Ann G. Nannarello

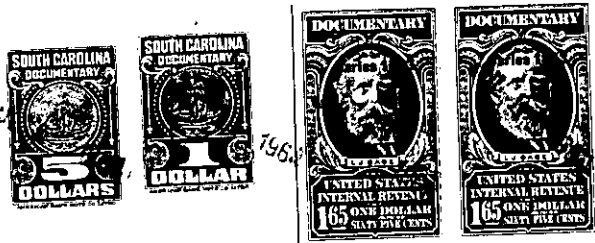
in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Twenty Eight Hundred Sixty and no/100 (\$2860.00) DOLLARS,
